TRANSPORTATION

If you don't want to rent a car – you don't need to! The Rapid Transit Service runs from inside Cleveland Hopkins Airport with a direct route and drop off inside Tower City Center. You only need to go up two floors to enter the Ritz-Carlton. From the Ritz-Carlton, we'll offer transportation to the university on Saturday morning. The Renaissance Cleveland Hotel is connected to the Ritz-Carlton Hotel by way of Tower City Center for the Saturday evening dinner.
