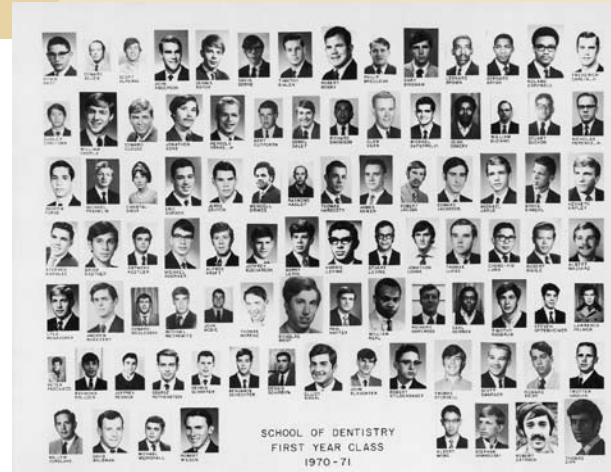

Reunion Giving Challenge

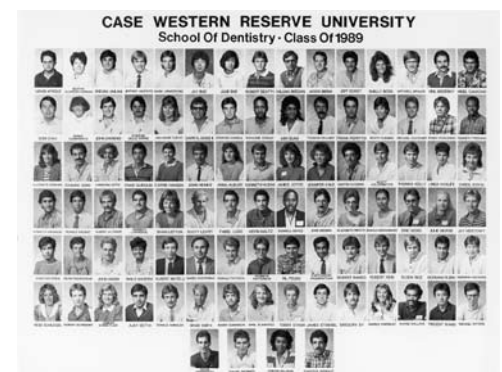
Give generously in honor of your reunion, win top honors

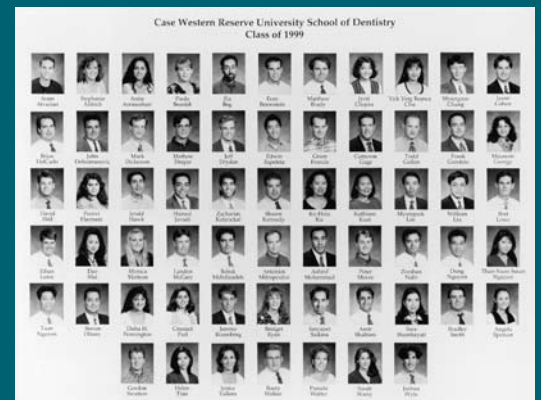
