Continuing Education Course – 2 Credit Hours
Pursuing the Ultimate in Esthetic Composite Restorations

Sillas Duarte, Jr., D.D.S., M.S., Ph.D., is an associate professor in the Department of Comprehensive Care at Case Western Reserve University School of Dental Medicine and maintains an intramural practice limited to esthetic dentistry. Performing successful and satisfying composite restorations is dependent on numerous factors. This lecture will focus on current key bonding principles and the dynamic effects of light transmission by various direct composite materials as a foundation to create imperceptible composite restorations. Optical properties of modern composite materials and their ability to impart translucency, opalescence and fluorescence are all critical toward developing natural appearing restorations (i.e., incisal translucency and halo). Successful adhesive restorations rely in the quality of bonding. However, differences on adhesive systems and teeth substrate can lead to a decrease of bond strengths. Bonding principles and post-op sensitivity will also be addressed with focus on esthetic restorations.
