

**Policy on Timely Registration**

School of Dental Medicine  
CASE WESTERN RESERVE UNIVERSITY

All advanced specialty education students in programs in endodontics, oral and maxillofacial surgery, orthodontics, pediatric dentistry, and periodontics must register twice each year in the School of Dental Medicine unless they are registered in another school of the University as part of a joint program with the School of Dental Medicine. Registration must be continuous to remain in the program of study. If the student anticipates any delay in registration, or the late payment of tuition/fees, the Dental Registrar (Barbara Sciulli) must be informed by the student. Registration is the responsibility of the student.

Participation in clinics and the treatment of patients is not permitted unless the student is registered. The student must ordinarily be registered at the time of their thesis defense.

Failure to comply with this policy of timely registration can result in loss of credit for time spent in program activities and is sufficient reason to separate the student from their program of study.
